CHURCH WALK OUTDOOR PADDLING POOL



The Paddling Pool has now re-opened. Advanced online booking is essential, **with all visitors required to book in advance**, walk-ins are not possible.

Everyone attending the pool is required to book, this includes adults who may not be planning to get into the paddling pool directly. Numbers attending need to be managed to ensure a safe experience for all. There are male/female toilets available which double as changing rooms. There is adequate seating around the pool and grassed area for picnics. Together with an onsite shop selling food and drinks there is an adjoining play area fully equipped.

- All children under the age of 16 require a parent/guardian to attend the session with them.
- You are only able to book one session per week – this is limited between each Monday-Sunday.
- The Paddling Pool is open 7 days a week until early September 2022, weather permitting. Two sessions are held each day 10 am – 1 pm and 2pm – 5pm.

The paddling pool is open 7 days a week from 28th May until early September 2022, with two Sessions each day. 10am – 1pm & 2pm 5pm.

There is no entrance or booking fee.
