



Witton Cemetery Path Refurbishment

Tender Document

Background

Witton Cemetery is situated in the town of Northwich Cheshire, the cemetery comprises of traditional and lawn graves set over multiple section within the site.

Post code – CW9 5PB

Northwich Town Council are looking for suitable contractors to carry out refurbishment works to the main path from St Helens Church through the cemetery. This is an active cemetery and burials are carried out on a regular basis, contractors will need to be respectful at all times and when a burial is taking place stop all works on site.

This path is also used when funerals take place so safe access will be needed as and when funerals are taking place within the cemetery.

Proposed Works

Please find below pictures and specification for path improvements in Witton Cemetery Northwich.

1. To remove existing kerbs being mindful not to disturb any graves that are close to the path and dispose legally off site.
2. To install approximately 400 linear metres of flat top concrete pin kerbs with concrete haunching.
3. Remove any loose or damaged existing tarmac and regulate path with suitable tarmac.
4. Finish with 6mm wearing (Hardstone) to top of kerb.
5. Reinstate with soil to the outside of kerbs.
6. Ensure site is finished to a high standard, all waste removed and disposed of legally.
