

Northwich Lions walk

A project delivered by Northwich Community Partnership, Northwich Town Council, Charles Darwin Community Primary School, The Russett School, Rosebank School and Cloughwood Academy.

Enjoy a gentle 30-minute walk, taking in Northwich's parks and spotting colourful lions along the way.

Walking Route Notes



Starting at Northwich Memorial Court, head to **Verdin park** via Watling Street and town bridge. Bear left and using the crossing, head into the main park gates and you'll see the first of the lions on the right.

From Verdin park, head to **Chinkers Field**, via Hayhurst Bridge. Follow Chester Way and head behind the Memorial Court, following the River Dane. You'll see Lion number 2 next to the higher footpath.





Carry on this route to **Vickers Way (Roker) Park**, where you'll find the 3rd lion by the aviary, opposite the friendly bench.

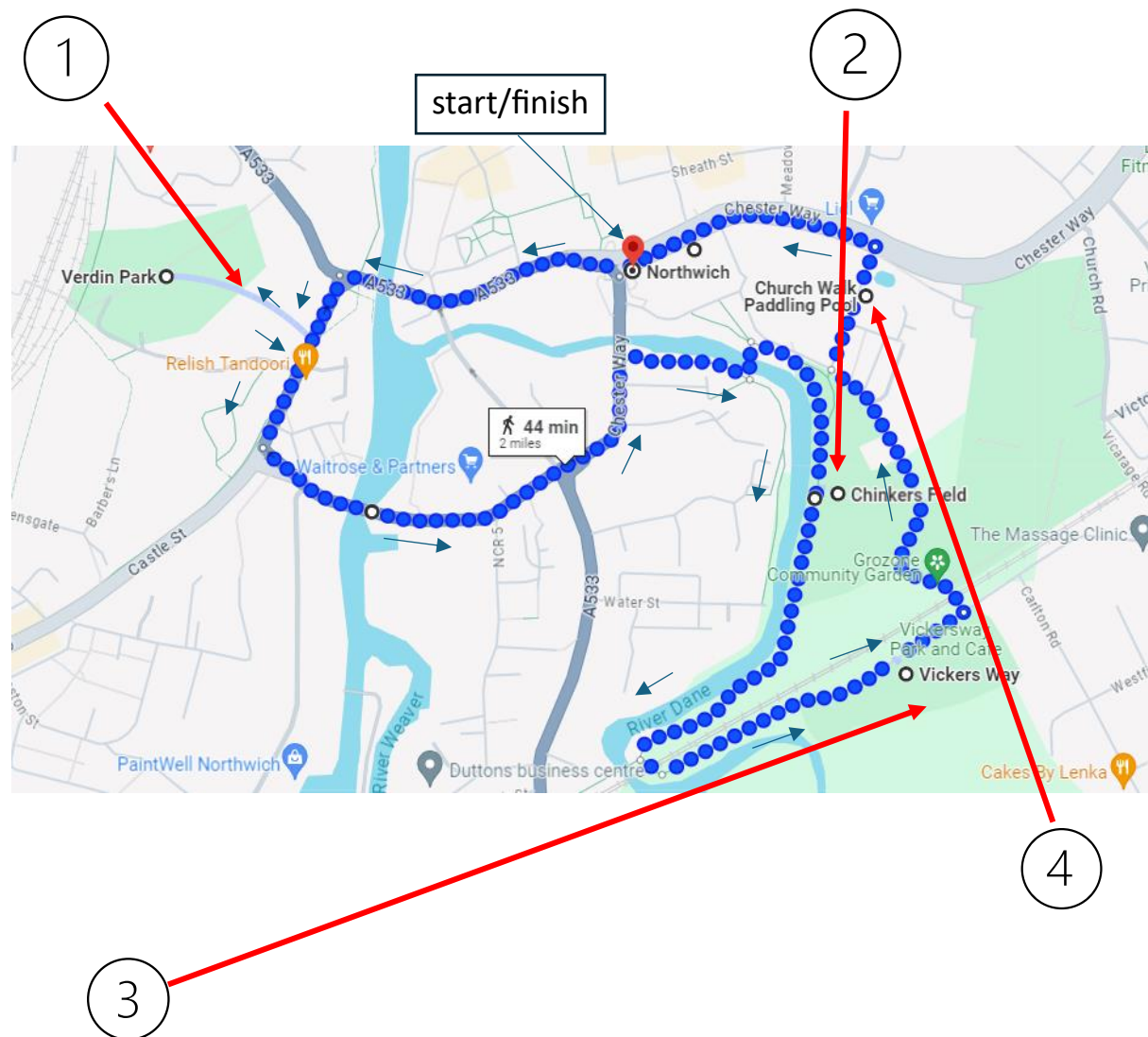
From Vickers Way Park, head under the arches and to the right to **Church Walk Paddling Pool**, where you'll find the last Lion to the right of the main gate.



Key points:

- Start and end at Northwich Memorial Court for easy parking
- All roads can be crossed using official traffic light crossings or subways
- The route crosses both of Northwich's historic swing bridges
- The route is accessible for wheelchairs and prams (please note, some of the lions are situated on grass)
- The route should take approx. 30 minutes of gentle walking
