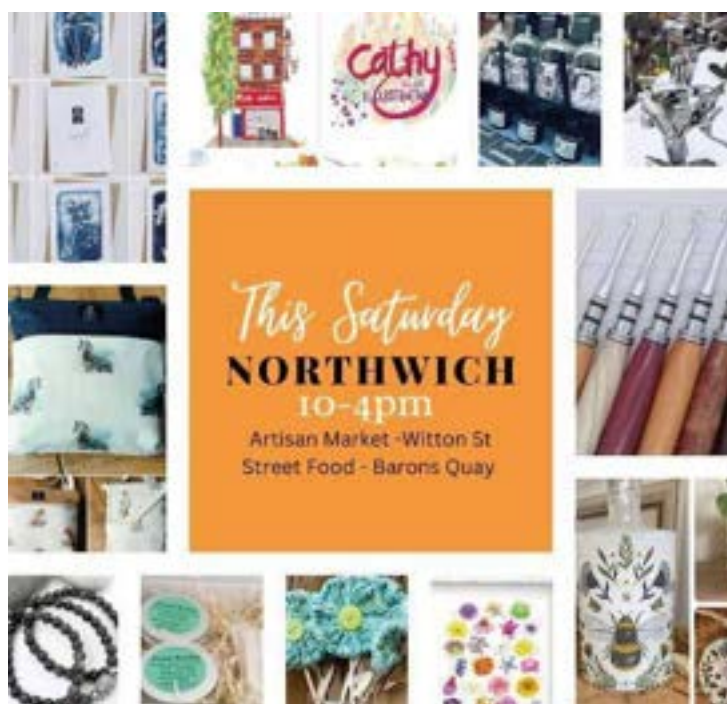

The Passing of Her Majesty, Queen Elizabeth the II

On Thursday 8th September Her Majesty Queen Elizabeth II sadly passed away while in Scotland. Following her death Operation London Bridge was implemented across the country, local authorities have been planning for this for some time and Northwich Town Council played an important role ensuring that the community of Northwich had the opportunity to mourn the Queens passing.



We worked alongside many partners throughout this sad time including CW&C Council, BRIO and Northwich BID who all worked exceptionally hard under difficult circumstances.

Automated External Defibrillator (AED)

We installed another AED at Castle Private Club; this is 24 hours accessible for the community. Funds were raised by Castle Private, Northwich Town Council, Northwich Rotary and Cllr Kate & Bob Cernik. This will be the 22nd AED that we have installed within Northwich which is managed and maintained by ourselves.



Northwest In Bloom

On Thursday 20th October we attended the In Bloom Awards Ceremony in Bolton with the BID and Changing Lives Together.

We are pleased to say that we came away with 5 golds which was a fantastic achievement for the town, CLT won gold for their work with volunteers at the food hub garden on Manchester Road, Grozone was another winner for its work in the community and we also won gold for Northwich and best large town.



There are too many people and organisations to thank as this is a joint partnership effort throughout the year so a big thanks to all involved with the continued hard work and commitment.

Northwich Town Council Community Orchard

Northwich Town Council along with Cheshire West and Chester, Grozone, the Community and Local Schools worked together to plant a community orchard across from Greenall Road. We have planted around 80 apple, plum and pear trees in this area. Workshops will be held on site along with open days once the trees are established where you will be able to learn to prune fruit trees.



Events and Initiatives

Remembrance Sunday

This year's Remembrance Parade in partnership with the Royal British Legion and St Helens Church was very well attended with St Helens church standing room only for the service.

This year we worked with local veterans to ensure they took their rightful place in the parade and in a prominent position at the cenotaph. We also for the first time had our own Union Flag which led the parade to and from the cenotaph and past the Mayor who took the salute.



Christmas Extravaganza

On Saturday 26th November we once again staged the Northwich Christmas Extravaganza which gets bigger and better year after year. This year was the biggest ever and we witnessed thousands of visitors converge on the town.

There was activity throughout the day to keep everybody entertained which included, games, crazy golf, Santa's Sleigh, Santa's grotto, fairground, various props, hot food and of course our very own Northwich Ice Rink.

The grand finale was the lantern parade in which 6 schools took part marching behind Batala Mersey and then the light switch on accompanied by snow in Barons Square and the day was topped off with a fantastic firework display from Riverside Park.



Wildflower Areas

Wildflower planting took place in April in these locations:

- Witton Cemetery
- St Helens Church Yard
- Verdin Park



Local schools took part in the planting and were able to watch the wild flower germinate into full colour in the coming months which looked amazing.

St Helens Churchyard Improvements

Northwich Town Council have been working with St Helens Church to make improvements to the church grounds, volunteers have been busy cutting back overgrown areas during the weekends and NTC staff have been removing the brash. Following on from this we have cultivated the banked area and this will be put to seed and maintained by NTC staff.

We are also supporting the St Helens Heritage Trail which the church volunteers have been working on for some time which will see a walk starting at the Church going to Carey/Marbury Park and returning to the Church.
