AND RECITING that the sd J.J.V. Cooke was desirous of being discharged from the trusts reltg to
the resdy estte of the Testr and the sd R.N.H. Verdin and J.J.V. Cooke were desirous of apptg
sd A.M. Verdin to be a Trustee in place of the sd J.J.V. Cooke

IT WAS WITNESSED that for effectuating the sd desire and in exercise of the power for that purpose
conferred by the Trustee Act 1925 and of all other powers enabling them in that behalf the sd R.N.H.
Verdin and J.J.V. Cooke thereby apptd the sd A.M. Verdin to be a trustee of the resdy estte of the Tes
in place of the sd J.J.V. Cooke and to act jointly with the sd R.N.H. Verdin for a ll such ppses of the
will as related to the resdy estte of the Testatr and the sd A.M. Verdin thereby consents to be a trustee
thereof accordingly.
